RE: 2<sup>nd</sup> Draft Fish Passage Design Criteria and Guidelines

Dear Mr. Young:

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NOAA Fisheries) has completed a revised draft version of its design criteria and guidelines document, intended for use for the design of a broad range of fish passage facilities. The subject document does not constitute rulemaking by NOAA Fisheries; rather, the intent is to provide a fish facility design document detailing features that have proven to be successful in getting passage facilities on the ground that operate reliably and provide optimum levels of fish protection. Revisions have been made to the initial draft document, based on comments received at workshops held in 2003, and based on internal review. NOAA Fisheries is in the process of developing explanatory drawings and expanding the bibliography associated with the document.

We request your review and invite comments from you and those copied with this letter. In addition, please feel free to release this document to others within your agency for their review.
